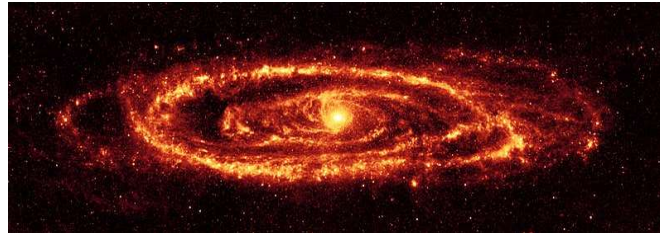


Emerging Science Is Going Online!

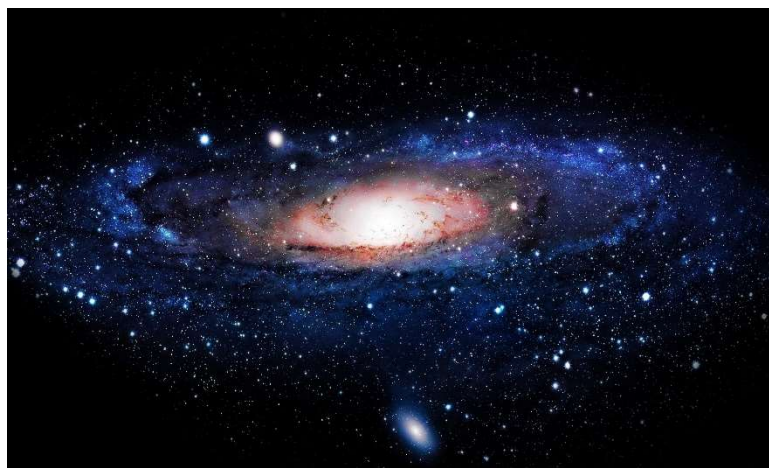
The PhD students of The University of NSW School of Chemistry have very kindly offered to present their sessions online during the Covid 19 shutdown of U3A.

They will be using Zoom. With Zoom, participants just get a link that they click at the appropriate time that directs them to a website. They can do this on their phones or computers. It shows all the participant's video stream (or a blank screen if they'd prefer) in a tile system. The speaker is in the middle of the screen and can screen share to show slides and talk as normal to them. The audience can ask questions easily.
